- Note 1 Basic compensation for a Member of the Legislative Assembly (MLA) is established under the *Members' Remuneration and Pensions Act.*
- Note 2 Members who hold parliamentary positions receive an additional salary that corresponds to a percentage of their basic compensation. If an MLA concurrently holds two or more positions for which an additional salary is granted, the MLA will receive only the higher amount.
- Note 3 Members that hold an executive position in government receive an additional salary that corresponds to a percentage of their basic compensation.

 Ministerial salaries are subject to a holdback of 20 percent, payable upon meeting the conditions as outlined in the *Balanced Budget and Ministerial Accountability Act*. All Ministers met their collective and individual targets for the prior fiscal year. As a result, the amounts being held back were paid to them during the current reporting period. These amounts, totaling \$237,234, are not included in this report.

Following the election and the resulting change in government, amounts held back to Members who were ministers during the period April 1, 2017 to July 17, 2017 were also paid. All of these former Ministers met their collective and individual targets for that period. These amounts, totalling \$71,199, are not included in this report.

- Note 4 The 40th Parliament was dissolved on April 11, 2017 for the May 9 provincial general election. The 41st Parliament opened on June 22. This report includes compensation received by returning Members, new Members, and non-returning Members, and as such, the remuneration for each of these groups is not comparable. - Note 5 Christy Clark resigned as a Member of the Legislative Assembly on August 4, 2017. Ben Stewart was elected as a Member of the Legislative Assembly in a by-election on February 14, 2018.
