LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR	The Queen's Representative in each Province whose approval is needed for a bill to become law.
OPPOSITION LEADER	The leader of the governing party and the head of the provincial government.
PREMIER	An MLA designated by a caucus to coordinate House business.
SERGEANT-AT-ARMS	The senior permanent Officer of the House responsible for providing advice on parliamentary procedure.
SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE	A group composed of MLAs of a given party.
WHIP	An MLA not belonging to the governing party, who is the head of another political party.


