Budget 2024 Consultation now open

VICTORIA – The Select Standing Committee on Finance and Government Services’ Budget 2024 consultation is now open.

British Columbians are invited to share their priorities for the next provincial budget by providing written input by Friday, June 16, 2023, at 2 p.m. (Pacific time). Public hearings are also being held beginning Monday, May 29 with the presentation of the *Budget 2024 Consultation Paper* by the Minister of Finance.
