**COMMERCIAL TRANSPORT
AMENDMENT ACT, 2024**

Explanatory Notes

CLAUSE 1: *[Commercial Transport Act, section 6]* makes a housekeeping amendment.

CLAUSE 2: *[Commercial Transport Act, section 12]* increases the maximum monetary penalty on operators from \$500 to \$100 000 and adds a penalty of imprisonment for not more than 18 months.

COMMERCIAL TRANSPORT AMENDMENT ACT, 2024

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:

- 1** *Section 6 (4) (c) (iii) of the Commercial Transport Act, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 58, is amended by striking out “sections 212.1, section 218.1” and substituting “section 212.1 or 218.1”.*
- 2** *Section 12 is amended*
 - (a)** *in subsection (2) (a) by striking out “not more than \$500,” and substituting “not more than \$100 000 or to imprisonment for not more than 18 months, or to both,”*
 - (b)** *in subsection (2) (b) by striking out “not more than \$500 and,” and substituting “not more than \$100 000, or to imprisonment for not more than 18 months, or to both, and,” and*
 - (c)** *in subsection (4) by striking out “not more than \$500” and substituting “not more than \$100 000 or to imprisonment for not more than 18 months, or to both”.*

Commencement

- 3** This Act comes into force on the date of Royal Assent.
